About the Qualification

This qualification provides candidates with the necessary skills and knowledge to provide basic treatment to one or more species of animal. It covers health & safety, legislation relating to the use of Veterinary Medicines, signs of health and ill health in various species, safe and correct procedures for administering Veterinary Medicines and the procedures for monitoring the animal's response and the actions to take in the case of an emergency.

Do these qualifications form part of a recognised framework?

The qualifications are accredited by Ofqual onto the Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF) at level 3.

Assessment

The units will be assessed by a GOLA test and one to one practical assessment by an NPTC assessor.

For learners

In the first instance you need to contact a registered Assessment Centre who offers this qualification. To find your nearest centre, go to the City & Guilds website (www.cityandguilds.com). Click on the City & Guilds red car to stay on the City & Guilds site. Then select 'Learners' and then 'Adult learners'. Then select 'Land-based' from the drop down list on the right hand side. Follow the prompts through to the qualification that you are looking for. If you click on the qualification, you can then enter your postcode to find your nearest Assessment Centre.

The Centre will be able to advise you on the training and assessment of the qualification.

For centres

If you are an existing approved centre for other qualifications, you will need to complete a qualification approval form (City & Guilds NPTC's QAP). The cost of this is £200 and you should contact verification@nptc.org.uk.
